In December the Council and the EU Parliament gave their final political confirmation on the "patent package" proposed by the EC, putting a final end in the discussions first initiated in the 70s. The "patent package" includes agreements on the creation of a EU Patent

with unitary effect (also called as Unitary Patent), the language system to be used and on the Unified Patent Court, the responsible court for the litigation procedures.

# 2012 - Regional Innovation Monitor Report "Credible Actions Key to Regions' Future Innovation Performance"

Building upon the findings of the first 2 RIM Annual Reports, this report which is a 3<sup>rd</sup>/final in its series deliverable, presents an updated analysis of innovation policies across EU regions, incorporates the results of the recently published Regional Innovation Scoreboard 2012, provides an account of benefits which have arisen from improved regional innovation practices. Key messages:

- Effective policies can make an important difference with a view to a region's development. The RIM repository (incl. 1,081 regional innovation policy support measures) documents that dynamic development goes along with good policy practice, i.e. measures with favourable assessments.
- 2. There are no simple solutions to complex issues. On the one hand, the above suggests that lagging regions should study the practices of those which have already put effective policies in place. On the other hand, this should not be done without studying the regional preconditions beforehand.
- 3. In regions with competences in the area of higher education policies one would expect to identify policy actions in support of the attraction of research personnel at universities, the transfer of skilled graduates to local firms as well as skills development on the job through training programmes. In practice, this proves not always to be the case. Arguably, there are several reasons for this situation. In fact, good human capital policies are one of the most central preconditions to make many other policies work. Regional innovation policies and (higher) education policies are thus also natural issues to coordinate at the EC level.
- 4. Finally, a more responsive approach to governance will be required, to lead, coordinate and implement systemic changes through regional innovation policies. Beyond providing framework conditions and infrastructure, responsive regional innovation policy should aim to play the role of a catalyst rather than one of a creator.

Regional innovational policy in UE needs to respect conclusions from analysis of UE interregional socio- cultural differences. Characteristic area are different reasons of imbalances on labour market and the migration for the job. **More...** http://www.rim-europa.eu/index.cfm?q=p.reportDetails&id=16508

# EUROSTARS, Deadline: April 4, 2013

Eurostars Programme is a European Joint Programme dedicated to the R&D performing SMEs\*, and co-funded by the European Communities and 33 EUREKA member countries. However, even if your organisation is based outside of the member countries of Eurostars, you may still be eligible to participate in a Eurostars project in addition to the minimum of two participants established in two different Eurostars member countries.

Eurostars aims to stimulate these SMEs to lead international collaborative research and innovation projects by easing access to support and funding. It is fine-tuned to focus on the needs of SMEs, and specifically targets the development of new products, processes and services and the access to transnational and international markets.

# Zürich-Basel Plant Science Center (COFUND) – 3<sup>rd</sup> Call

Co-financed by Marie Curie COFUND, the Plant Science Center (PSC) at the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology Zurich (ETH Zurich) offers incoming and outgoing fellowships as well as reintegration grants for postdocs in the field of plant science at host organizations in Europe and third countries. The PLANT FELLOWS Programme will pay 40% of all the fellow's costs. The remaining 60% must be provided by the Principal Investigator of the host institution. The funding includes the Fellow's salary as well as an allowance for research costs and a mobility allowance. The deadline for the third Call is: 30 April 2013, at 5p.m. Zurich time.

# Open Innovation 2.0: Evolution or revolution?

Many people recognize that Innovation is not just an imperative for economic and social progress but that it is an art and skill which underpins the progress and survival of the human species. With advances in global information and communications technologies, the process and practice of Innovation is evolving and morphing at a very rapid pace. Last decade Henry Chesbrough (2003) neatly conceptualized and described the idea of open innovation where ideas can pass to and from different organizations for exploitation.

The EU Open Innovation Strategy and Policy group (OISPG) which unites industrial groups, academia and private users to support policies for Open Innovation at the European Commission, has been publishing an annual yearbook which summarizes and reports on current practices in innovation in Europe. In the past number of years we seem to be witnessing a new level of open innovation and an increasing sophistication and complexity associated with innovation. This paradigm, where a paradigm is defined as a set of practices which define a discipline at a point in time, could be described as Open Innovation 2.0.
