Innovation Scoreboard 2013

The **Innovation Union Scoreboard** provides a comparative assessment of the research and innovation performance of the EU Member States and the relative strengths and weaknesses of their research and innovation systems.

The result of the <u>European Commission Innovation Union Scoreboard 2013</u> shows that the Innovation performance in the EU has improved year on year in spite of the continuing economic crisis, but the innovation divide between Member States is widening. While the most innovative countries have further improved their performance, others have shown a lack of progress. According to the report, the **innovation leaders** are Sweden, Germany, Denmark, Finland, all showing a performance well above that of the EU average.

Six Components of a Great Corporate Culture

The benefits of a strong corporate culture are both intuitive, supported by social science. <u>According to James L. Heskett</u>, culture "can account for 20-30% of the differential in corporate performance when compared with 'culturally unremarkable' competitors." And HBR writers have offered advice on <u>navigating different geographic cultures</u>, <u>selecting jobs based on culture</u>, <u>changing cultures</u>, and <u>offering feedback across cultures</u>, among other topics.

But what makes a culture? Each culture is unique, myriad factors go into creating one, but I've observed at least six common components of great cultures. Isolating those elements can be the first step to building a differentiated culture and a lasting organization. 1. Vision. 2. Values. 3. Practices. 4. People. 5. Narrative. 6. Place.
