EU and Japan officially launched the negotiations for a Free Trade Agreement

The negotiations aim at coming to a comprehensive agreement in goods, services, investments, at eliminating tariffs, non-tariff barriers, at covering other trade-related issues, public procurement, regulatory issues, competition, sustainable development. This Agreement could become an important factor to boost the economies of EU and Japan, since Japan is the EU's 7th largest trading partner globally and the EU's 2nd biggest trading partner in Asia after China. Conversely, the EU is Japan's 3rd largest trading partner, after China and the United States. Together the EU & Japan account for more than one third of the world's GDP.

Re-inventing Europe's entrepreneurial spirit

Since the beginning of the economic crisis, self-employment in EU has become a less attractive option. The next EC should take an activist approach to promote entrepreneurship and further integrate individual markets, argues.

Today, as many as 58% of Europeans prefer to work as employees as opposed to 49% three years ago. In line with this, the World Bank has observed that EU citizens are prepared to accept lower, but "better" growth, with strong social security, a high level of public services At the same time, the EU youth population is often described as the "good enough" generation which prefers to adapt to the changing circumstances rather than conquer the world. EU has seen less intensive product competition, greater levels of regulation, difficulty in access to high-risk capital and a lower number of educated workers than the United States.
