#### Agreement on "HORIZON 2020": the EU's research and innovation programme for the years 2014 to 2020

The Committee of Permanent Representatives endorsed the agreement reached last June between the Presidency of the Council & the EU Parliament representatives on the "Horizon 2020" programme for research & innovation for 2014-2020. Horizon 2020 will replace the FP7, which runs until the end of 2013. Compared with FP7, the programme is expected to further eliminate fragmentation in the fields of scientific research & innovation.

Horizon 2020, which has a budget of around 70 billion euros, will underpin the objectives of the Europe 2020 strategy for growth & jobs, as well as the goal of strengthening the scientific & technological bases by contributing to achieving a European Research Area in which researchers, scientific knowledge, technology circulate freely. Priorities:

- 1. Generating excellent science in order to strengthen the Union's world-class scientific excellence and make the Union research and innovation system more competitive,
- 2. Fostering industrial leadership to speed up the development of technologies that will support businesses & innovation, including for small companies,
- 3. Tackling societal challenges in order to respond to the priorities identified in the Europe 2020 strategy by supporting activities covering the entire chain from research to market.

#### Europe's 'Horizon 2020' science funding programme: How is it shaping up? - Health Sector

In 2014, a new programme, Horizon 2020, will likely invest another €70 billion over 6 years. Health research has been a major part: between 12% & 17% was spent on official FP5 & FP6 health research lines, although our work categorizing all EU science projects puts the health-related investment proportion nearer to 20%. Here, we compare our analyses, experiences with the EC's own impact assessments, plans that inform the Horizon 2020 programme. Much is moving in the right direction but some key gaps are overlooked.

# Improving & Implementing National Energy Efficiency Strategies in the EU Framework - Findings from Energy Efficiency Watch II Analyses

The survey showed an enormous disparity among Member States in the levels of ambition of their energy efficiency policies. In some Member States, the recognition of the economic, social, political, environmental benefits of energy efficiency drives ambitious legislation, funding programmes whereas others just do the bare minimum required by the European Directives (and sometimes even less than that).

The conclusion is that national energy efficiency policy packages have to be improved in all relevant sectors to achieve additional energy savings of at least 1 % per year compared to autonomous energy efficiency improvements. 1% remains even modest if we know that the cost effective potential is even 2% per year. It will, therefore, bring net economic benefits to businesses/consumers in the Member States, if these are more ambitious in the implementation of EU Directives but also with their own measures.
