In this respect, the EU, as the rest of the world, faces a serious dilemma. World Nuclear Industry Status Report 2013

• A record decline in world nuclear power generation (-7% in 2012).

- A long term, steady drop of the nuclear share in global electricity production from 17% in 1993 to 10% in 2012.
- Rapid aging: average now 29 years with 190 units 30+ years in operation.
- Poor renewal with 6 units shutdowns vs. 3 startups in 2012 and 2 shutdowns vs. 1 startup in the first half of 2013.

• 800,000 tons of water in precarious storage at Fukushima contain 2.5 times the radioactivity released at Chernobyl.

• China, Germany, India and Japan, in 2012, generated more power from renewables than from nuclear plants. **More...** www.WorldNuclearReport.org

In line with EU Regulations, every year by 30 April, national authorities submit their forecast of requests for payments for the current, the following year, broken down by programme & Fund. In 2012 Member States overestimated their payment claims by 15% (20% in 2011). Denmark had the highest rate of overestimation, followed by Romania and Cyprus.

The report notes that 'Germany overestimated its payments by 26%. As its payment claims represent 7.8% of the total claims, this forecast error also had a substantial influence on the overall average. Hungary, Italy had a relatively limited overestimation of 16% & 15% respectively but as their payment claims represent 5.8% & 6.9% of the total value, these forecast errors had a relevant influence on the overall average'. Poland, Spain, Finland, Austria had the lowest estimation errors. Only four countries underestimated their payment requests (Austria, Sweden, Portugal, Luxembourg).
