Cluster Identification

Caution! Politicians (and too often funders) welcome such broad engagement. But a danger is that the common development agendas for broad groups can have little impact on individual businesses. Whilst the cluster may be named in these broad terms, the areas of specialisation (and therefore engagement) within such clusters need to be clear. What are the cluster's Hot Spots?

Caution! The geographic catchment area for a cluster tends to align with local commuting patterns. There is still a tight geography to tacit information flows and firm co-specialisation. However, don't expect all of the cluster's stakeholders to be based within the region. And build up to national agendas by linking related regional clusters.

Cluster Governance

One of the most common reasons for the failure of clustering initiatives is an inappropriate Board. The Board needs to be led by business, not a public agency. Initially this Board is carefully selec ted; look for the change makers. Mistakes are hard to rectify. Elections come later. And when reviewing a clustering initiative think through: Do we still have tomorrow's leaders? Are these the players, or the spectators? Some Boards permit substitutions at their meetings. Again ...

Caution! It is difficult with temporary participants to build the necessary trust, to coalesce and to engage effectively as a driving team. Advice: No substitutes at Board meetings.

Unified Patent Court Website

The Agreement on the **Unified Patent Court** was signed by 25 EU Member States, with the aim of **creating a specialised patent court** with exclusive jurisdiction for litigation relating to EU patents - a bundle of national patents with no single jurisdiction for disputes -

and EU patents with unitary effect, a legal title ensuring uniform protection for an invention across 25 Member States on a one-stop shop basis, providing huge cost advantages, reducing burdens.

Nuclear waste management and environmental impact research at JRC

JRC activities with regards to the management of high level nuclear waste continue to follow the two major options chosen in the EU: geological disposal, where the major objective is to prevent the release of radio nuclides to the biosphere over a very long time scale, partitioning, transmutation, which is an alternative waste management strategy that would considerably reduce the radio-toxicity of waste in activity & in time.

The variety of these activities is reflected in seven sub agendas:

It is based on a study of secondary sources, information provided by 38 EARTO members and a piece of simple economic modelling intended to complement the qualitative and micro descriptions of impact contained in the existing literature with a more macroeconomic perspective. In discussions about research, there is often confusion about whether there are overlaps or even duplication between RTOs and universities. Data about what these organisations actually do make it clear that their activities are complementary.
