Call for personal and post-doctoral research grant applications 2013

The **call for post-doctoral research applications** will be open from 1 September to 17:00 (Estonian time) on 30 September 2013. The post-doctoral research grant is a research grant that the Estonian Research Council (ETAg) will award to an applicant as a result of an open international competition for the purpose of implementation of a particular research project. The grant includes remuneration of the post-doctoral fellow (27,000 euro annually incl. taxes payable thereon), research-related costs (for an experimental research project -6,000 euro, for a non-experimental research project - 3,200 euro).

European Mobility Week kicks off: Cities put focus on transport & clean air (16-22/09/13)

European Mobility Week (EMW) 2013 officially launches today, and will see more than 2,000 cities in 43 countries implement activities to create a more sustainable mobility culture. This year's edition will run from 16 to 22 September under the slogan 'Clean air – It's your move!'

The 2013 campaign aims to raise awareness about the impact of transport on local air quality, and encourages citizens all over Europe to improve their health and well-being by changing their day-to-day mobility behaviour. It coincides with the European Year of Air, an area EU policy makers are currently reviewing through the Thematic Strategy on Air Quality.

Poor air quality continues to have a major impact on the health of European citizens, leading to respiratory and cardiac complications, premature deaths and shorter life expectancy. Air pollution also affects the environment, resulting in acidification, biodiversity loss, ozone depletion and climate change. Urban traffic is a growing source of air pollution – specifically when it comes to particulate matter and nitrogen dioxide. **More...**
