The EC contracted the law firm Baker & McKenzie to carry out a study on the role of trade secrets and confidential business information as possible drivers for innovation, competitiveness and economic growth in the EU.

This study incorporates a survey covering 537 companies, including 323 small and medium size companies (less than 250 employees) undertaken at the end of 2012. It also provides a detailed review of the legal frameworks governing trade secrets in the 27 Member States, the United States of America, Japan and Switzerland.

Supporting Investment in Knowledge Capital, Growth and Innovation

Supporting Investment in Knowledge Capital, Growth and Innovation is the latest OECD publication that reveals the significance of business investment in what is called knowledge based capital (KCB). KCB consists of non-physical assets such as data, software, patents, designs, new organisational processes and firm-specific skills.

The key findings of the publication show that investing in knowledge-based capital is crucial to developing, maintaining a healthy innovation ecosystem. Business investment in knowledge based capital is a key factor in driving growth in knowledge economies. The report shows that it contributes to 20-34% of average labour productivity growth in the EU.

Adopting and supporting a broader concept of innovation (also explored in the OECD "<u>Oslo Manual</u>") would allow policymakers to support SMEs more completely in all of the kinds of innovation they can be involved in, including innovations in marketing strategies, organisational structure and function.

The upcoming <u>European Council meeting</u> on growth, competitiveness & innovation on the 24-25 October should take into account these new figures when coming to their conclusions on Europe's collective future in innovation.

An open call for expression of interest for the financial instruments under COSME

The new Programme for the Competitiveness of Enterprises and Small and Medium-sized Enterprises (COSME) will run from 2014 to 2020, with a planned budget of €2.3bn (current prices). Objectives

- facilitating access to finance for Small and Medium-sized Enterprises (SMEs)
- creating an environment favourable to business creation and growth
- encouraging an entrepreneurial culture in Europe
- increasing the sustainable competitiveness of EU companies
- helping small businesses operate outside their home countries and improving their access to markets

As regards the financial instruments to be implemented under COSME, these are implemented on a demand-driven basis. While the EC will incentivise the EU Investment Fund (the entity most likely to be entrusted with the implementation of the financial instruments) to work with financial intermediaries across a wide geography, the entrusted entity can only respond to requests from financial intermediaries but not force financial intermediaries to apply.

An open call for expression of interest will be launched for the financial instruments under COSME, allowing equal access to the facilities across financial intermediaries from participating countries. This call for expression of interest will also set out the detailed terms and conditions of the financial instruments which will be binding for all financial intermediaries. URBACT Call for Proposals for the Creation of Pilot Networks

Following the decision of the URBACT Monitoring Committee an URBACT Call for proposals is now open for the creation of up to 4 Pilot Networks for the transfer of good practice in the field of integrated, sustainable urban development.

In URBACT II, the focus of exchange networks has been on fostering integrated and participative approaches to urban policies through sharing experience and practices, and improving local policies (production of Local Action Plans). Action Plan to make Europe's cities smarter

Commission expected to invest around €200m to create Smart Cities in the next two years.

Cities are the major source of EU economic activity and of innovation. But the global economy is developing, changing fast and European cities need to rise to new challenges, develop & improve.

The plan suggests improvements to the way that cities are run with better ways of involving citizens, more collaborative ways of doing things. It suggests innovation zones, new business models, a re-evaluation of rules, legislation, a more standardised approach to data collection, use to enable better comparisons between approaches, between cities.
