- infrastructures, interests, market structure, policies R&D frameworks, current status of research programmes, international positioning and cooperation etc.
- to create a roadmap that will maximize both the overall EU-EECA cooperation in ICT Research;
- to ringing together European Technology platforms and Knowledge networks which will assist EU & EECA countries in identifying new ICT policies;
- to organize trainings and information events about Work Programme 2014-2015 of H2020;
- to elaborate and disseminate the Catalogue of Research Groups from EECA region.

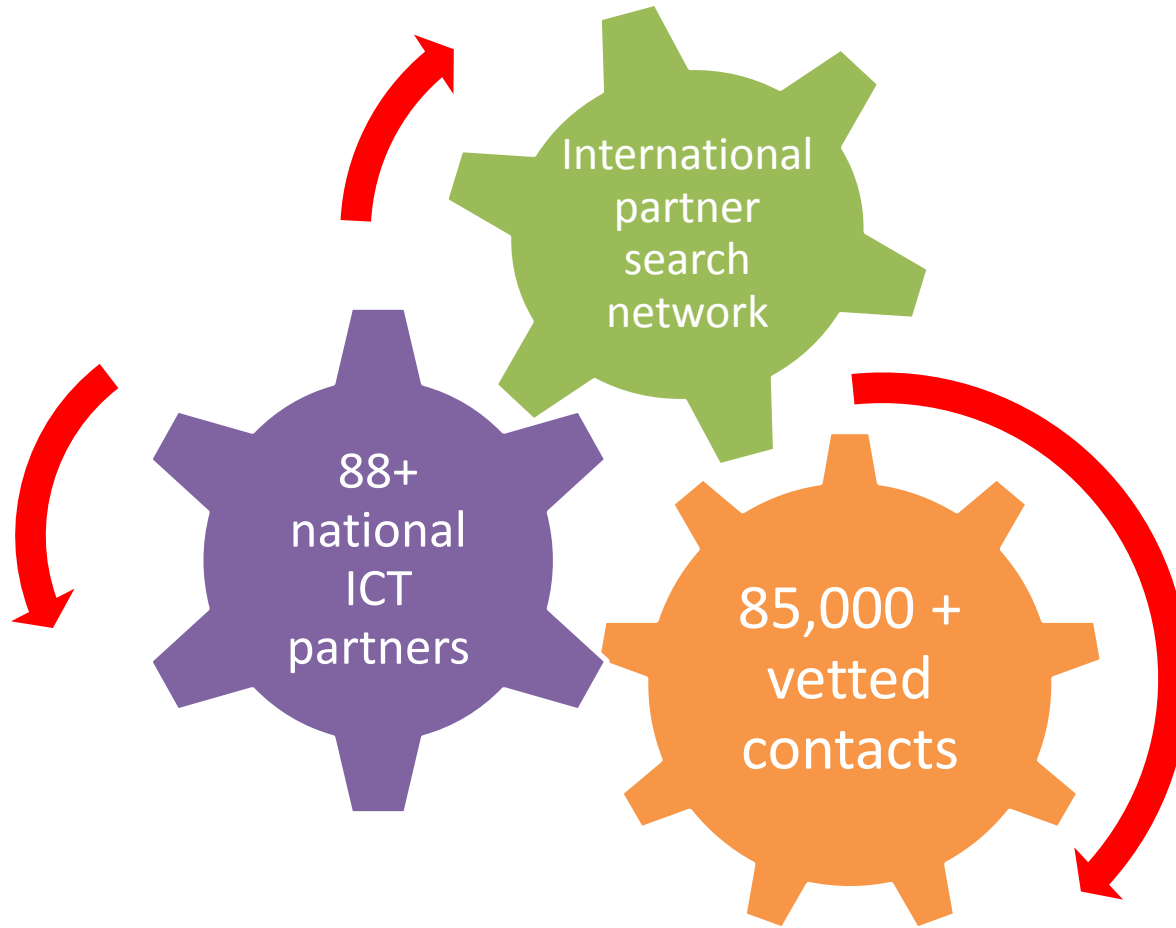

Proposer replies to EOIs (Standard reply form) & chooses partner(s) to build consortium (98% success rate)

PS is closed & Proposer fills in feedback form

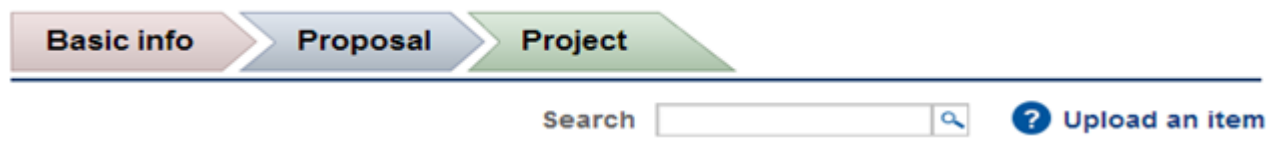
