# Belarus experience in FP7. Some prospects for Horizon-2020

## The statistics of Belarus participation in FP7 (2007-2013)

- Belarus takes 20<sup>th</sup> place among third countries by number of applicants and the declared amount of financing
- 282 applications for participation in 467 calls were submitted. The declared amount financing was 38.52 million euros.
- Success rate was 19.9%
- 56 applications were supported.
- 44 Mary-Curie-Actions and 20 IRSES projects were financed.

- For October 20, 2013 36 contracts with 45 partners from Belarus were signed with financing of 3.43 millions euros.
- Our partners are the scientists from Germany (43), Israel (34), England (33), Italy (30).
- 634 partners are participating in these projects, and the total amount of their financing makes 149 million euros.
- Ratio of research, development and coordination projects is – 1:2,5

## How to raise a share of scientific and innovative projects?

- It follows from our experience that those have chances whose scope of work (service) completely corresponds the description under full coincidence of interests (economic, social) of EU and this country
- Who has skilled, active and reliable partners in EU countries,
- Who has the confirmed scientific results of the international level on a project subject,
- Who has experience of the international cooperation etc.

An effective instrument of coordination of cooperation between EC and EaP is Inconet which identifys in EaP countries the players potentially interested in expansion of cooperation in the priority directions taking into account the national scientific programmes, bilateral projects with the EU/AC the countries, various the international projects etc.

#### IncoNet EaP - basic facts

- The aim coordination and assistance to cooperation between EC and EaP
- Duration -3 years, beginning September 2013
- Budget 3 mln. Euros
- Actually, this is continuation of Inconet EECA
- Thematic focus climate, energetics and health
- Consortium consists of 19 partners from 6 EaP countries and 10 EC member states
- Belarus partner is Belarus Institute of System Analysis

#### IncoNet EaP - kinds activities

- 1. Coordination of EC-EaP cooperation in climate, energetics and health directions
- 2. Scientific and analytical activities providing the cooperation
- 3. Support of biregional dialogues concerning scientific and innovation policy
- 4. Assistance to participation in the program Horizon-2020
- Assistance of innovative activity, information support of EC-EaP cooperation

#### Inconet EaP and Horizon-2020

- Development of networks of national contact points to train the potential participants and distribute the information on Horizon-2020 etc.
- Organization of information days for the Horizon-2020 program
- Providing the travel grants for scientists to participate in brokery events of EU/AC
- Analysis of opportunities of participation of scientists from EU in national scientific programs of EaP countries

Important task is development of instruments for simplification of participation of EaP scientists in the projects of Horizon-2020 because objective and subjective difficulties of joining EaP scientists to the consortia still exist. These mechanisms should elaborated within the multi-annual regional roadmap which will be developed in near future according to declaration of Vilnius meeting on 30th September -1st October last year.

- What can be suggested for that?
- These can be:
  - EaP-targeted collaborative projects (similarly to SME-targeted projects) or
  - -SICA Specific International Cooperation Actions (collaborative projects with obligatory participation of the EaP countries)
