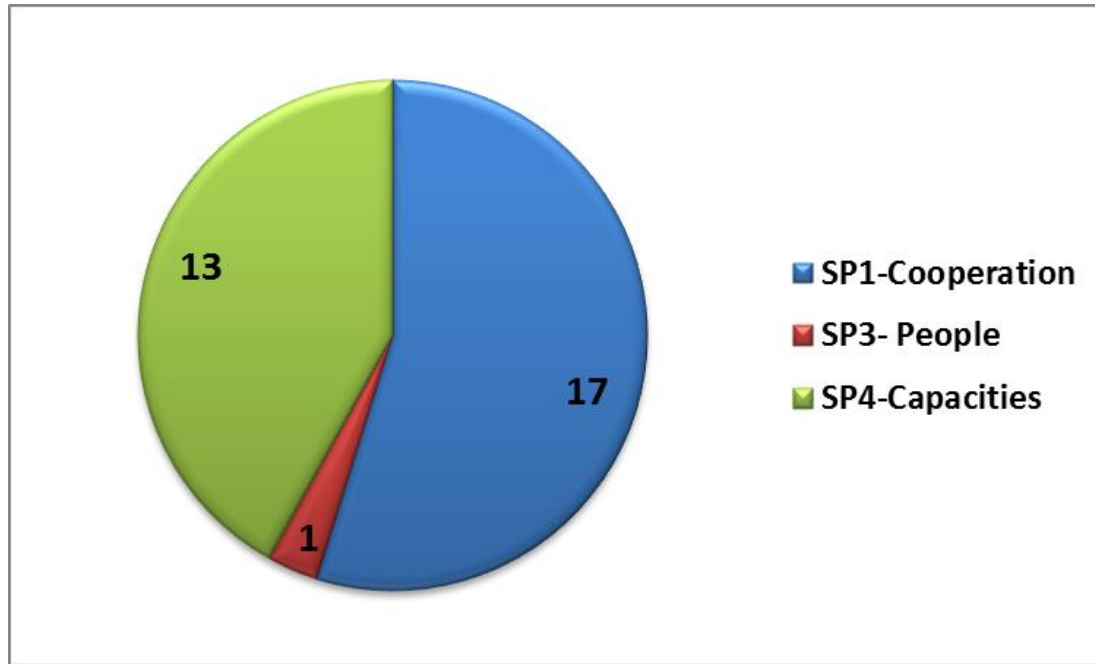

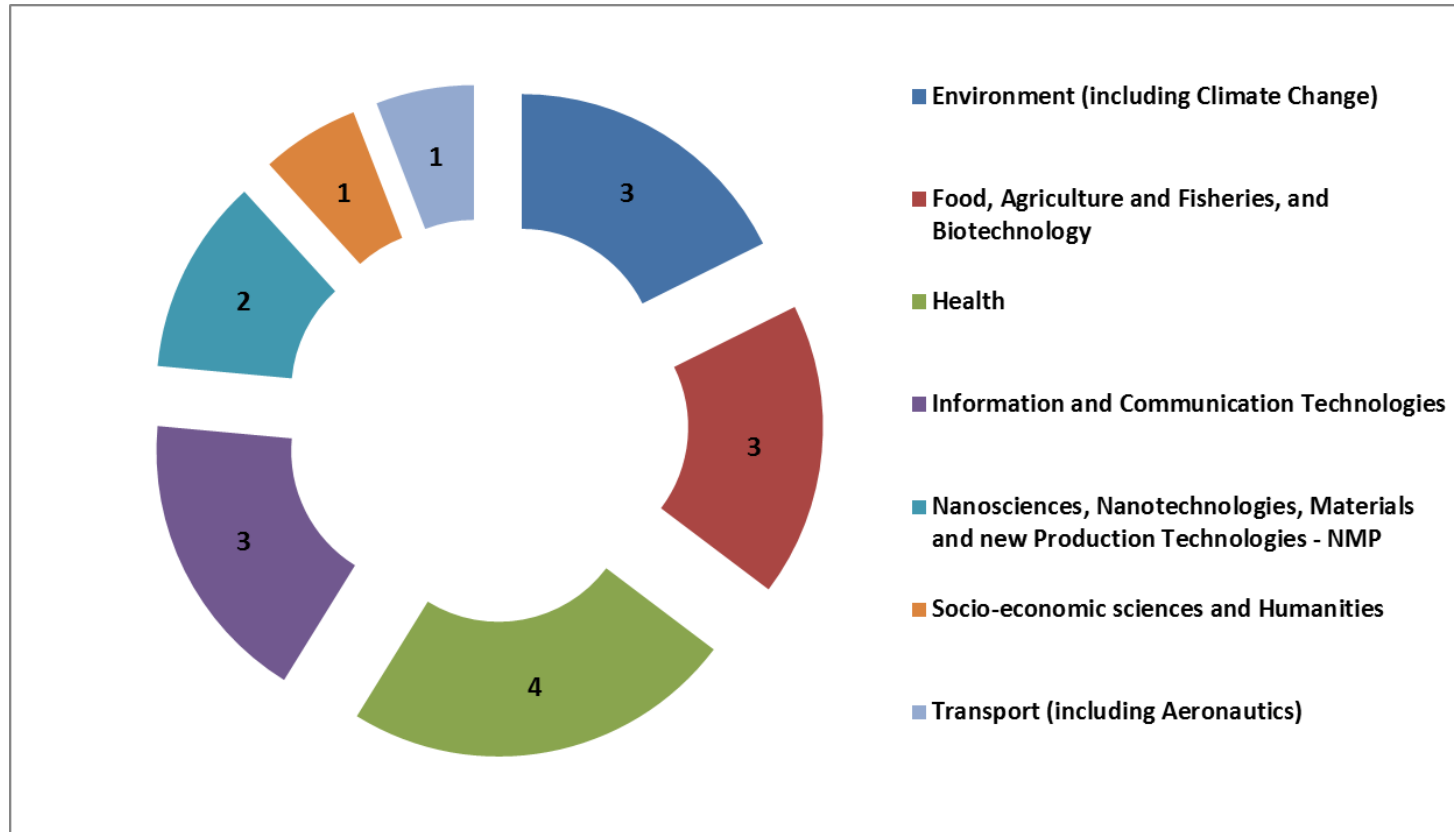


40 participations of 24 Georgian institutions in the 31 FP7 funded projects.

Cooperation Specific Programme




FP7-HEALTH - HITT-2008

 - ▶ **Coordinated by France's Centre de coopération Internationale en Recherche Agronomique pour le Développement (CIRAD).**
 - ▶ **The project is dedicated to investigating the biological, ecological and epidemiological components of vector-borne disease introduction, emergence and spread, and the creation of new tools to control them.**

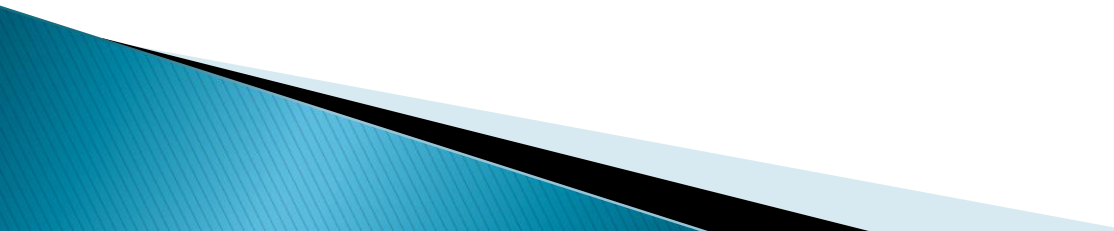
Georgian Partner

- ▶ **Main activities:**
 - Public Health State Programs
 - Communicable Disease Surveillance
 - Non-communicable Disease Surveillance
 - Environmental Health

 - Public Health Laboratories and their Network Coverage


Georgian Partner

- ▶ **The National Centre for Disease Control (NCDC) is the primary public health center in Georgia which performs surveillance, control and prevention of public health diseases.**
- ▶ **The Georgian team is carrying out field and laboratory work to investigate the vectors of visceral leishmaniasis in Georgia.**
- ▶ **These results will help to determine the epidemiological significance of each vector, which is essential in developing appropriate control measures for disease prevention.**

FP7-HEALTH - PSYCHCNVS

- ▶ Copy number variations conferring risk of psychiatric disorders in children.
 - ▶ From 2009-01-01 to 2012-06-30
 - ▶ Small or medium-scale focused research project
 - ▶ Coordinated by deCODE genetics, Iceland
 - ▶ The objective of this study was to generate new knowledge on genetic variants conferring risk of psychiatric disorders in children and adolescents.

Georgian Partner

- ▶ **Tbilisi State Medical University**
 - ▶ **Tbilisi State Medical University – a Legal Entity of Public Law – is an autonomous higher education institution having the 80 years history since its foundation.**
 - ▶ **Five faculties and 58 departments**
 - ▶ **PSYCHCNVS partners from Georgia have translated key instruments for diagnosing schizophrenia, bipolar and autistic subjects.**

FP7 Health - EECALINK

- ▶ Promotion and facilitation of international cooperation with Eastern European and Central Asian countries
- ▶ From 2009-06-01 to 2011-11-30
- ▶ Coordination (or networking) actions
- ▶ Coordinated by Charles University in Prague, Czech Republic.
- ▶ The project was aimed at identification of common research priorities of the European Union and Eastern European and Central Asian countries (EECA) and strengthening collaboration among them.

Georgian Partner

- ▶ **Tbilisi State University**
- ▶ **The first-ever national university in the Caucasus was opened in 1918.**
- ▶ **TSU is one of the largest higher educational institutions. Today about 22 thousand students are undergoing studies at six faculties of University.**
- ▶ **TSU is one of the first scientific-research institutions of Georgia. It implements about 200 local and international scientific grant programs annually.**
- ▶ **TSU is an active member of leading international education networks.**

- ▶ Encouragement and promotion of the international collaboration through systematic support to creation of new research consortia and submitting proposals to the Health thematic priority of FP and Public Health Programme.
- ▶ Stimulation of the further development of research consortia for FP7 and Public Health calls and supports in preparation of their project proposals .
- ▶ Identification of joint research interest of the EECA and the EU Member States and assure their effective communication to the relevant policy makers.
- ▶ Strengthening and broadening of the existing research collaboration among participating university /academia partners.
- ▶ Building up and strengthening the capacities of participating EECA countries for effective collaboration within the FP7 projects and in their administration.
