Object: Expression of interest - Marie Skłodowska-Curie Individual Fellowships (IF)

Sapienza University of Rome invites eligible researchers of any nationality to express their interest in applying jointly for a Marie Skłodowska-Curie Individual Fellowships.

About Marie Skłodowska-Curie Individual Fellowships

Marie Skłodowska-Curie Individual Fellowships (IF) promote the mobility of researchers (both inside and outside of Europe) as well as attracting the best foreign researchers to work in the EU. The grant provides a salary (minimum 12 months, maximum 24 months) and a mobility allowance, as well as covering research expenses and overhead costs for the host institution. Individual researchers may submit proposals for funding in liaison with a host organization. Proposals are evaluated on the basis of their research quality, the researcher's career prospects and the support provided by the host organisation.

Who can apply?

Researchers may be of any nationality and must have either a doctoral degree or at least 4 years full-time research experience. At the time of the proposal submission deadline, researchers must not have resided or carried out their main activity (work, studies, etc.) in Italy for more than 12 months during the 3 previous years immediately prior to the reference date.

As part of its mission to promote a research culture and environment, Sapienza University of Rome invites eligible researchers to apply jointly for a Marie Skłodowska-Curie Individual Fellowships (IF).
