### **Objectives and Rationale**

The competition based allocation of public funding in research and innovation has become the most important funding principle, competitive measures require sophisticated and at the same time practical procedures for the selection of the best fitting applications for funding. The quality and transparency of evaluation has a direct impact i.e. on the promotion of scientific excellence and efficiency of research funding. Beside the ex-ante evaluation for project selection by peer reviews, evaluation has received in the last decades more attention from a systemic point of view, namely for the justification of public spending, for learning about the functionality of the existing funding system, the funding portfolio.

During the event, different initiatives will showcase their approach reaching from national practice to international networking initiatives and the established joint peer review systems of funding agencies.

The ultimative outcome of the meeting would be to draft the next steps of a joint regional S&T peer review platform that will help Eastern Partnership countries to improve their evaluation systems by pooling national experts, creating additional capacities and elaborating procedures on a comparable basis. A regional roadmap for RTDI evaluation will be drafted that will give orientation for the next steps.

Background: During the sessions of the regional workshop "Science evaluation as a prerequisite for promoting excellence in research" (November 6, 2012, Chisinau) the participants expressed their principal readiness of creating a regional platform for evaluation of national R&D programs and projects, as a first step for further introduction of international peer review. In favor of this idea is the existence of a wide range of bilateral grant schemes among EaP countries and also with EU MS funding agencies.

#### Main goals:

- Update on existing regional capacities on S&T evaluation and expertise, sharing national and regional best practicies of S&T evaluation
- > Identifying the mechanisms for establishing a regional platform on S&T evaluation
- Prepairing a MoU for a regional peer review data base of evaluators
- Advancing the cooperation between EU/MS and EaP countries on evaluation
