Clusters

Cluster Observatory

The concept of clusters originates with Harvard Professor Michael Porter, who also has been the driving force behind the cluster mapping methodology. Professor Porter had worked out his model which could statistically define, describe clusters across the economy. The mapping consisted of two fundamental parts:

- Development of cluster codes which can identify and measure industrial agglomeration within regions
- Development of performance measures (the size, specialization, competitiveness, dynamism) of clusters

A set of 41 so called "traded cluster" codes were decided on, accounting for roughly one third of the total employment.

Synergies between European Structural & Investment Funds, Horizon 2020 & other research, innovation, competitiveness-related Union programmes

Although there has been a substantial increase in the budget of Horizon 2020 (almost EUR 80 billion) compared to the previous research framework programmes and although there has been a steep increase of the innovation and competitiveness-related budgets under cohesion policy over the past decade⁵, it is of utmost importance to ensure optimal

synergies between the funds to face the ever increasing competitive pressure from global markets and maximize impact and efficiency of public funding⁶. The European Parliament and Council made it clear

that this approach is no more a "nice to have" but a "need to implement". This political will needs to permeate all layers of stakeholders, at Member State level as well as EC services level, including intermediaries, facilitators' networks.

Technology Request from Hungary: Methods for Minimising Fat Migration

We are looking for new, innovative ways of minimizing fat migration between the components within a confectionery product. **The proposed technology should be:** An ingredient that could be added to one or more components; An

ingredient that will "lock in" or "lock out" fat, blocking fat and moisture migration; Edible i.e. non toxic; Appropriate for use in confectionery; Compatible with chocolate. **Possible Approaches Include, but are Not Limited To:**

- Materials that will absorb/adsorb the fat over time and slow the rate of migration. Careful control of the absorption/adsorption will be required to allow the free fat to aid processing and be released on consumption to benefit the textural experience.
- Self assembling barrier layers that can form a barrier at the interface of a two confectionery components. The barrier should not dominate the eating experience.
- Self assembling molecules that can develop a lipid network that can withstand moderate levels of shear and / or not requiring high temperatures to establish the network.
