6th Ambient Assisted Living Joint Programme - AAL Forum, 9-12 September 2014, Bucharest, Romania

The **AAL Ambient Assisted Living program** (<http://www.aal-europe.eu/>) is a research program aiming to support, fund research projects to enhance the quality of life of older people and strengthen the industrial base in Europe through the use of ICT.

The Ambient Assisted Living Joint Programme (AAL JP) is an initiative involving 22 countries and its main objectives are to improve the living conditions of older adults through the use and development of AAL solutions and to strengthen the competitiveness of European industry in the AAL domain.

The **AAL Forum**, expected to attract around 700 AAL participants from all over Europe and beyond, is the annual showcase event for the people involved in the AAL JP's projects and the AAL community. It is the core connection of the joint programme to the AAL Community. This community includes policy makers, ICT developers, manufacturers, health professionals, commissioners, businesses, venture companies, technologists, academics, designers, caretakers and of course older adults. Its purpose is to exhibit and demonstrate existing or developing ICT solutions (products and services), promote networking within the community, foster the interest of other sectors in the field of AAL, provoke debate and discussion on various topics and highlight new or emerging developments in the area to inform the AAL community.

The **6th AAL Forum** will be organized under the title "**Broader, Bigger, Better – AAL solutions for EU**".

This is an annual platform for the increasing European **AAL community** support its' meetings during which to discuss update topics, relevant for improving the [AAL Joint Programme](http://www.aal-europe.eu/). The event will show best practices examples of successful solutions, evaluate the impact in terms of increased independence for older adults and the economic growth.

The AAL event offers a forum for the European AAL community to meet, discuss several topics, relevant for improving the AAL programme, the adoption of ICT for ageing solutions in the market.
