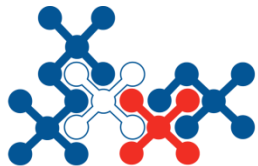

What is the road to a Framework Programme success story?





1. Identify your field of expertise

Know what are your strenghts and weaknesses?

What is your organisation good at?

What are your long term objectives?

Do you have the proper resources to start research projects?

Are you in need of developing a new project/product/ipr?





Get yourself acquainted with an array of funding programmes

Does the idea of Framework Research Programmes (currently Horizon 2020) match your needs?

Are there any other programmes that might be used to your advantage?

Have you tried contacting the NCP network or the EEN network?





Framework Programme – drafting a project

- Browse through the workprogrammes
- Select a suitable call and funding instrument
- Make sure that there was no project that performed the same activities as the ones you are intending to make!
- Get yourself acquainted with what similar projects have been funded



Building a consortium

- **Make sure that all of the members of the consortium have a clear role in the project**
- **Make sure that the coordinator is an experienced and credible organization**
- **Make sure that you sign a clear and a just consortium agreement that includes the division of the IPR**
- **Check the clauses of the Model Grant Agreement in order to prepare yourself for what it takes to implement a framework programme project**

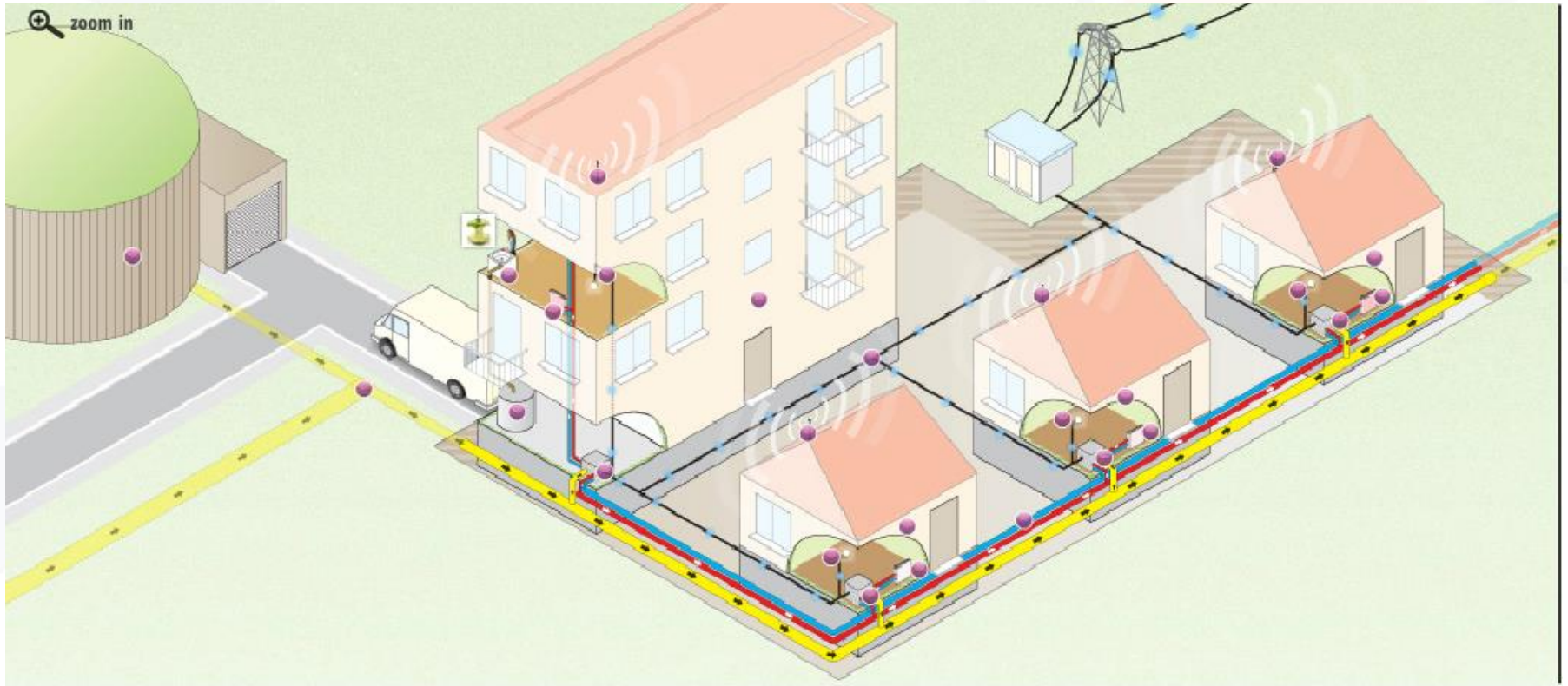


Overall objective:
