LAUNCH OF THE SMART SPECIALISATION PLATFORM FOR AGRI-FOOD & SMART SPECIALISATION PLATFORM FOR INDUSTRIAL MODERNISATION



The new <u>Smart Specialisation Platform for Agri-Food</u> and <u>Smart Specialisation Platform for Industrial</u> <u>Modernisation</u> were launched during the June <u>Smart Regions conference</u>. These new platforms will offer hands-on support to regions to foster interregional cooperation based on matching smart specialisation priorities related to Agri-food and Industrial Modernisation. They will be hosted by the European Commission's Smart Specialisation Platform located in Seville.

The aim of this initiative is to **create an investment pipeline of mature projects in new growth areas across the EU**, by providing tailored advice and helping regions establish links with the business and research communities. The platforms could help regions develop or share infrastructure such as testing facilities, pilot plants, data centres, and Fab-Labs. Particular support will be given to regions to combine different EU investment instruments, such as the <u>European Structural and Investment (ESI)</u> <u>Funds, COSME, Horizon2020</u> and the European Fund for Strategic Investments (EFSI), the heart of the <u>Investment Plan</u>.

S3 PLATFORM LAUNCHES A NEW PROJECT ON HIGHER EDUCATION



The <u>Higher Education in Smart Specialisation (HESS)</u> project includes action research in two S3 Platform regions: Navarre in Spain and North East Romania. It aims to analyse how higher education can help implement S3 at regional level, both in the supply of skills and knowledge relevant to the region's priorities, and its broader engagement with the economy and society. Introductory meetings have already been held in Pamplona and Iaşi. More field work including peer review will take place in the autumn. The results of the action research can provide inspiration for other members of the S3 Platform, and a focused handbook on the subject will be published in the first half of 2017. The project will also analyse how the ESI Funds are being spent on Higher Education across the EU as a whole.



NEW PROJECT ON RIS3 IN LAGGING REGIONS

Building on the outcomes of the <u>RIS3 in REMTh (Region of Eastern Macedonia and Thrace, Greece)</u>, the <u>RIS3 in Lagging Regions project</u> provides appropriate and specific support to the implementation of RIS3 in selected regions where growth is slow or limited. It also develops a cross-cutting approach to key issues regarding growth and governance in those regions.

Two Entrepreneurial Discovery Process (EDP) focus groups were co-organized with the Regional Development Agencies of North-West and North East Romania. The aim of both events was to bring together relevant stakeholders in the priority sectors of cosmetics and biotechnology, respectively, to explore and catalyse the dynamics of the entrepreneurial process of discovery, to examine the key criteria to identify and pursue relevant projects for the region, and to further refine the focus group approach for its future application in other regions:

- Entrepreneurial Discovery Focus Group on biotechnology, North-East Region, Romania (lași, Romania)

- Focus Group on cosmetics and food supplements based on natural resources (Cluj, Romania)
